PETITION ALLEGING THE CHILD
IS A CHILD IN NEED OF ASSIS-
TANCE

COMES NOW the Petitioner and
states to the Court that:

1. R L M, SSN: DOB: March 19,
2021, is a minor residing in Calhoun
County.

2. The names and residences of
the parents of said child are as fol-
lows:

(a) Mother: Samantha Lauer, 217
N Hughitt St., Lake City, IA 51449

(b) Father: Unknown

3. The child has no other legal
guardian.

4. The child has no other legal
custodian.

5. The name of said child's guard-
ian ad litem/attorney is: Mary Lau-
ver.

6. The child named above is un-
married and is a child in need of
assistance as defined in Iowa Code
Section 232.96A, subparagraphs
3(b) and (14):

232.96A(3)- The child has suffered
or is imminently likely to suffer
harmful effects as a result of any of
the following:

(b). The failure of the child's par-
ent, guardian, custodian, or other
member of the household in which
the child resides to exercise a rea-
sonable degree of care in supervis-
ing the child.

232.96A(14)- The Child's parents,
guardian, or custodian suffers from
a mental incapacity or a mental
condition, imprisonment, or drug
or alcohol abuse that results in the
child not receiving adequate care
or being imminently likely not to re-
ceive adequate care.

7. The child is within this Court's
jurisdiction on the basis of the fol-
lowing facts: The mother has ad-
mitted to using methamphetamines
since her last CINA case closed on
June 21, 2022. The mother's physi-
cal appearance, pock marks on her
face, arms and legs, would tend
to support that the mother is using
methamphetamines. The mother
and child are living with the mater-
nal grandmother, who also admits
to using methamphetamines. The
mother is having contact with Tylor
Meyers and has a history of using
illegal substances with him.

WHEREFORE, the undersigned
prays that the Court: (1) set a time
and place for hearing on the Peti-
tion; (2) order that notice be directed
to all parties in interest in a manner
provided by law; and (3) upon hear-
ing, adjudicate the above-named
child a child in need of assistance.

YOU ARE further notified that
unless you appear thereto and de-
fend at the time and place identified
that adjudication maybe decreed as
prayed for in this petition.
