Mayor Heinlen called the meeting to order with the following members present: Fowler, Porter, Gentry, Fistler and Rokes.

Motion was made by Gentry, second by Rokes, to approve the agenda, unanimous.

Motion by Rokes, second by Fowler, to approve the consent agenda consisting of the March 7 meeting minutes, bills as submitted and 5-day Liquor License for Calhoun County Exposition, unanimous

This being the time and place, Mayor Heinlen opened the public hearing for discussion on the FY23 Budget. There were no oral or written comments.

Motion was made by Gentry, second by Rokes, to close the public hearing, unanimous.

Motion by Porter, second by Fowler, to allow Calhoun County to rent the Community Center for elections the next 10 years, unanimous. Auditor Robin Batz will send a schedule, at the beginning of each year.

Motion by Rokes, second by Fistler, to approve the use of the Calhoun County Exposition's go cart track North of Austin Street, unanimous. Kelly Meyer and Darren Legore told the Council they did not know how often there would be races, but that it should not be loud and there would not be any alcohol consumed at the site.

Motion by Fistler, second by Rokes, to approve the bid by Certified Testing at a cost of \$6,240.00 for soil borings to test soil on a proposed housing addition, unanimous.

Motion by Rokes, second by Fowler, to approve change order # 3 to John T. Jones for work on the Sewer Plant project, unanimous.

Motion by Gentry, second by Porter, to approve payment #13 for \$38,213.43 to John T. Jones for work on the Sewer Plant project, unanimous.

Motion by Gentry, second by Rokes, to approve Resolution 22-11 FY23 Budget, unanimous.

Motion by Fistler, second by Fowler, to hold the City-Wide Garage sale on May 28 and Clean Up Day June 4, unanimous.

Motion by Rokes, second by Fistler, to allow a dog park South of the tennis court, unanimous. There will be rules to use the park as recommended by the City's Insurance provider and City attorney.

Motion by Gentry, second by Rokes, to approve the fiber permit running fiber into town to the Mid-American Energy facility, unanimous.

There was an update on EMS meetings that had been taking place the last several months. The Board of Supervisors made a vote prior to a recommendation from the committee. The Board will meet Tuesday at 9:30 at the Courthouse to further discuss.

Mayor Heinlen called for further business, and with none, motion by Gen-

try, second by Rokes to adjourn the meeting at 6:50 PM, unanimous. Next meeting will be a closed special session Monday, April 4 at 5:00 and then at 5:30 the regular meeting at City Hall.
