**LAKE CITY COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
MARCH 7, 2022**

These minutes are as recorded by the City Administrator / Clerk and are subject to council approval at the next council meeting.

The City Council of Lake City met in regular session at 5:00 p.m. with Mayor Holm presiding and the following members present: Wilson, Bellinghausen, Bruns, and Daniel. Council Member Gorden arrived at 5:02 p.m. Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Daniel motioned, Bellinghausen seconded, to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the Agenda, Minutes from the February 21<sup>st</sup> and March 1<sup>st</sup> meetings, the Summary List of Claims below, the Treasurer's Report for February 2022, and a Class C Beer Permit for Sparky's One Stop.

Tiffany Blair addressed the council with a request for an exemption to the chicken ordinance in town for approximately 8 weeks this summer. Calhoun County 4-H is partnering with the local food banks in Calhoun County to provide fresh poultry to those in need in Calhoun County. Currently the chicken permit in Lake City is for owning a maximum of six chickens. Tiffany asked the council for a one-time exemption so the 4-H members could raise up to ten for the summer, exhibit them at the Calhoun County Expo, and then donate them to the local food banks. Wilson motioned, Gorden seconded, to allow the exemption to the chicken permit for the summer for the 4-H project. All Ayes, MC.

Gorden motioned, Daniel seconded, to set the Public Hearing date for March 21<sup>st</sup> at 5:00 p.m. for the USDA Application for a Police Vehicle. All Ayes, MC.

Brunns motioned, Wilson seconded, to approve the request for a chicken permit at 607 W Main St. All Ayes, MC.

Bellinghausen motioned, Daniel seconded, to approve the hiring of Jason Gray as a Police Officer. All Ayes, MC.

CA Wood discussed the recent meeting with John Panning from Dobson Organ, and representatives from Corn Belt Power Cooperative and Calhoun County REC. Dobson Organ is looking to break ground on their new building in the fall of 2022. Council Member Gorden addressed the Easter Egg hunt this spring scheduled for April 16<sup>th</sup> at either Goins Park or the City Square. CA Wood reminded the council of the EMS meeting scheduled for Wednesday night in Manson at the MAC Center and discussed receiving two Calhoun County Foundation grants - one for Police computers and one for equipment for the new Fire Department water wagon.

There being no further business, Daniel motioned, Bellinghausen seconded, to adjourn at 5:20 p.m. All Ayes, MC.

The next council meeting is scheduled for March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. in the City Hall Chambers.
